Team 2 – E3 Jessica Nagel, E2 Christian Groff, E2 Decklan Eaden

Team 1 took 1<sup>st</sup> place on the Obstacle Course and Heist events, Team 2 took 2<sup>nd</sup> place in those events, giving us 1<sup>st</sup> place in the pool events and securing slots for Team 1 to Nationals in Mississippi 16-19 MAY.

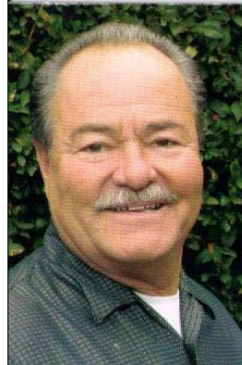
